Fifth COMMANDMENT HONOR THY FATHER AND THY MOTHER

LESSON #6

READ: Exo.20:12

1. INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Ten Commandments can be divided into two sections.
- 2. The first four deal with man's relationship with God.
- 3. The last six deal with man's relationship with man.
- 4. Thus, man's obligations are both vertical and horizontal.
- 5. We learn from a study of the Ten Commandments that God will not be pleased until we meet our obligations to both man and God.
- 6. The Deut. account Deut.5:16 READ differs slightly and is restated a little differently in Lev.19:3 READ
- 7. This is the first of the commandments dealing with man's relationship to man.
- 8. This should tell us something about its importance.
- 9. Also, keeping the first four would make it easier to keep this one.

LET'S LOOK AT THE WORD HONOR.

- 1. HONOR = Respect, reverence, high esteem, and to acknowledge worth or value.
- 2. When people address their parents as the old man or old lady, they are in violation of this law.
- 3. Lev.19:32 READ,
- 4. 1 Tim.5:4 READ,

WHY SHOULD WE HONOR OUR PARENTS?

- 1. Some reasons:
 - a. Because they gave us life.
 - b. They sustained us.
 - c. They cared for us when we could not care for ourselves.
 - d. Out of sheer gratitude, we should want to hold our parents in high esteem.
 - e. Honoring our parents prepares us to honor God.
 - f. God commands it.

HOW SHOULD WE HONOR PARENTS?

- 1. By obeying them. Prov.1:8 READ,
- 2. Eph.6:1-3 READ,
 - a. What did Paul mean by in the Lord?
 - i. Could it be that these verses refer to children who are in the Lord or that children should only obey parents that are in the Lord?
- 3. No, the phrase, in the Lord, refers to that which is in harmony with God's will.
 - a. Col.3:20 READ,
 - b. The consequences of failing to obey parents, was disastrous in the Mosaic Age. Deut. 21:18-21 READ:
 - c. NOTICE Rom.1:30-31 READ Gives a list of people who are worthy of death, among this list is, "those disobedient to parents".
- 4. Is there ever a time to disobey your parents?
 - a. Yes, when they hinder one's obedience to the will of God children must put God first. Matt.10:37 READ, Matt.6:33 READ.
- 5. We honor parents by not cursing them. Exo.21:17,READ, Lev.20:9 says about the same but adds, "his blood shall be upon him."
 - a. By not mocking them or despising them. Prov.30:17 READ.
 - b. A failure to strike one's parents offers them the reverence and respect they deserve. Exo.21:15 READ.

WE CAN ACKNOWLEDGE THE VALUE OR WORTH OF OUR PARENTS BY CARING FOR THEM IN TIME OF NEED.

- 1. What are we going to do with them when they get old and helpless? The Bible has a lot to say about this:
 - a. Prov.23:22 READ.
 - b. 1 Tim.5:4, Vrs.8, Vrs.16, READ.
 - c. Dear friend, when our parents cannot walk, we should carry them.
 - d. When they cannot feed themselves, we should feed them,
 - e. when they cannot dress themselves, we should dress them.
- 2. Jesus set the example for all of us to follow.
 - a. Luke 2:51 READ
 - b. Even while on the cross Jesus thought of taking care of his mother. Jn.19:27 READ,

PARENTS SHOULD LIVE HONORABLY IF THEY ARE TO BE HONORED.

A great example would be Eunice.

Paul said she had an unfeigned faith, and had passed it on to Timothy.

From a babe Timothy had known the sacred writings which were able to make one wise unto salvation. (2 Tim.1:5).

Abraham was an honorable father worthy of the honor that God requires of parents.

Gen.18:19 describes him, READ

Parents who should be honored are those who discipline their children. Eph.6:4, READ

Parents who wish to be respected should also be parents who give their children the leadership that they need. Prov.22:6, READ
