READ: Exo.20:14

1. INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The sin of adultery is tearing our nation and the church apart.
- 2. This is not a pleasant subject.
 - a. We wish we could skip over this commandment.
 - b. But the time is overdue to cry aloud, and like Paul preach the whole counsel of God. (Acts 20:27).
- 3. What is adultery? = Comes from a root word that is akin to idolatry.
 - a. It is unlawful sexual relations between two people who are married but not to each other, or between one single person and a married person.
 - b. Often fornication and adultery are used synonymously.

A. DISCUSSION:

LET'S DISCUSS FOUR KINDS OF ADULTERY MENTIONED IN THE BIBLE.

- 1. Physical adultery. Gen.2:18 READ.
- 1. Moses told Israel, Lev. 18:20, READ.
- 2. David committed physical adultery. 2 Sam.11:4, READ
- 3. God said in Jer.5:7; Vrs.9 READ.
- 4. Paul wrote, 1 Cor.7:2, READ.
 - 2. Mental adultery.
- 5. Matt.15:19, Jesus said that fornication and adultery begins in the heart.
- 6. Matt.5:27-28, READ
- 7. Prov.23:7, READ
- 8. In 2 Pet.2:14 READ, Peter wrote of those who had eyes of adultery, who could not cease from sin.
 - 3. LEGAL ADULTERY: There are multitudes who are considered married according to civil law, yet they have no right to be married according to God's law.
- 9. Matt.19:6 Jesus said, READ.
- 10. Rom.7:2, READ.
- 11. Jesus was very clear when He said, Matt.19:9, READ.
- 12. Divorce for any other reason other than fornication is not acceptable to God.
 - 4. SPIRITUAL ADULTERY: Jer.3:9, a description of Israel, READ.
- 13. Rom.7:4 Paul taught that we are married to Christ READ.
- 14. 2 Cor.11:2, READ.
- 15. James tells us that we can commit adultery with the world. Jas. 4:4, READ.
 - 5. THIS COMMANDMENT NOT ONLY FORBIDS ADULTERY AND

- 6. FORNICATION, IT FORBIDS, RAPE, SEDUCTION, LEWDNESS, WANTONNESS, LASCIVIOUSNESS, POLYGAMY, SODOMY, WHOREDOM, HOMOSEXUALITY, BESTIALITY, AND PORNOGRAPHY.
- 7. II. LET'S LOOK AT THE CURSE OF THOSE CONNECTED WITH VIOLATING THIS COMMANDMENT.
 - a. Lev.20:10, READ.
 - b. Prov.6:27-29, READ
 - c. Prov.6:32, READ.
 - d. Heb.13:4, READ
 - e. John wrote that fornicators or adulterers would be in hell. (Rev.21:8 & 27; 22:15 READ).

WHY IS ADULTERY WRONG?

- 1. It is a sin against society. Prov.14:34, READ.
- 2. Adultery destroys the home, the sacredness of mother hood and child hood. In Mal.2:16, READ,God declared that he hated putting away.
- 3. Adultery is a sin against one's body. 1 Cor.6:18, READ.
- 4. Venereal disease and Aids is at epidemic proportions.
- 5. Adultery has a devastating impact on the personality.
- 6. It leaves people ashamed.
- 7. Many struggle with a guilt complex.
- 8. Like David, Psa.51:3, READ.
- 9. Adultery destroys the soul. Prov.6:32, READ.
- 10. Adultery is a sin against God. Joseph said, (Gen.39:9).
- 11. David admitted it was a sin against God by saying, "I have sinned against Jehovah." (2 Sam.12:13).

WHAT CAN WE DO IF WE HAVE COMMITTED ADULTERY? & WHAT CAN WE DO TO KEEP FROM COMMITTING ADULTERY?

- 1. Adultery can be forgiven.
 - a. The woman at the well who had 5 husbands was offered a drink of the water of life. (Jn.4:1-26).
 - b. Jesus when confronted by the Pharisees and Scribes, with a woman taken in the very act of adultery.
 - c. He first asked those without sin to carry out the stoning to death.
 - d. Then after all her accusers had walked away He asked "women where are they? Did no man condemn thee: and she said no man, Lord.. Jesus said, neither do I condemn; go thy way and sin no more."
 - e. Jesus did not condone what she did, he called it what it was sin.
 - f. But he offered hope to the hopeless, when he offered her a chance to start a new life.
- 2. Christians that break this commandment need to be restored. Gal.6:1 READ.
 - a. 1 Jn.1:9 READ.
- 3. We can avoid engaging in adultery by staying away from, dancing, drinking, most movies, pornography, most T.V., a lot of music, petting etc.
- 4. You may think that these are extreme suggestions.
- 5. 2. Well think again, for they all play a major role in motivating millions to commit adultery every day.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. God not only forbids the acts of adultery.
 - a. He also forbids the attitudes that precedes it.
- 2. The curse upon those who engage in adultery is exceedingly plain.
 - a. But thanks to God, we can declare adultery as not the unpardonable sin.
 - b. There is hope for those caught in the web of adultery.
 - c. The answer is Christ.
